
After successful organization of workshop you are to submit the following documents

TRUSTEES:

All the above noted/mentioned Trustees appointed under this Trust shall be permanent Members for life. Any person who is over 12 years of age subscribing to the objects of the trust and accepted as a donor on his paying a donation decided by the trust member or more shall be entitles as a Trustee at the sole discretion of the majority of the Life Trustees.

Trustees belonging to all categories mentioned above should constitute the General Body of the Trust, which shall meet at least once in a year.

1TRUSTEE:

The number of Trustees including life members shall not be more than 10 (ten)

The Chairman/Managing Trustee/ Settler in consultation with the other Life Members shall be competent to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above or remove any Trustee except the Life Members at any time without assigning any reason thereof in addition to this the Chairman may appoint an Advisory Committee to aid and advice the Board of Trustees from time to time.

Any Trustees may resign by giving notice in writing to the Chairman. In case of any vacancy in the Board of Trustee (except Life Members) cause by death. Resignation removal or otherwise the same be filled up by nomination by the Chairman in consultation with the Life Members. But in case of the vacancy caused by the death or resignation of the Permanent/ Life members, the remaining life members shall be competent to select any persons to be taken in that vacant space. However the Chairman has the option to nominate his/her successor such successor shall remain enforce and exercise such power or powers in the same manner as the nominator could do personally.

HONORARY TRUSTEES:

Distinguished citizens nominated by the life members may be appointed as Honory Trustee.

That, the Trust shall unanimously agree that a person is of a extraordinary eminence in particular stream or an eminent worker; if he wants, shall be life member like the members or Governing Council or

Managing Committee of the Trust. For such purpose, such person shall become an Honorary Members after due approval of the Chairman or Managing Trustees.

CORPUS FUND:

All property and funds of the trust shall belong to the trust collectively and no individual member shall have any proprietary rights over them.

The children having intimate relationship with an employee of the trust shall be treated as free students of the institution of the Trust.

GOVERNING COUNCIL:

There shall be Governing Council to manage the affairs of the Trust.

The first Governing Council shall consist of the Life Trustees.

The trustees elected to the Governing Council shall hold office for a period of two years. But they shall be eligible for re-election. The term of governing council shall be for a period of two years.

In the event of the arising any vacancy in any of the offices mentioned above in Clause 5.1 upper, such vacancy shall be filled in from amongst the other trustees by election or by majority decision of the Trustees.

If necessary a Secretary shall be appointed by the chairman from amongst the members of the governing council.

The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the governing council and general body. In case the Chairman is absent from any meeting, the Trustees shall elect one amongst themselves to be chairman for the meeting.

TRUST'S RECORDS:

All the records, minute books, title deeds, securities, account books, vouchers, papers and documents in relation to the trust shall maintain and remain at the head office of the trust and at such places as the trust may from time to time determine.

ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

The Trustees shall keep or cause to be kept true and proper account of all money received and disbursed or spent for the objects and purposes of the trust.

A Chartered Accountant shall duly audit the accounts of the trust every year of the financial year ending on 31st March

BANK ACCOUNT

That, the Settlor open Bank in any Nationalized/Private Bank, in the name of the Trust and the such Account's will be operated by Settlor only .

The accounts of the Trust shall be reckoned from 1st April each year 31st March of the following year.

MEETING:

The Trustees, from time to time, shall arrange meeting among themselves to decide the prospects and the objects of the trust and shall make themselves available to such meeting as and when convened by the managing trustee or chairman, who shall be responsible for day to day affair and conduct of the trust and convening the meeting etc.

The notice of the meeting of the trustees and all communications shall be sent by the managing trustees at the last known address of the trustees by registered post or under certificate of posting and record shall be kept. The entire managing trustee may time to time think fit as far as possible the same shall be convened at the head office of the trust.

Two third of the total number or three of the Trustees whichever is lower, present at any meeting shall be quorum for the meeting.

The majority of the votes shall decide all proceedings and questions arising at the meeting of the trustees but the things, which are specifically provided to be done in a particular manner in the presents, shall not be distributed by the amendment of this clause.

The meetings of the proceedings of the trust shall be entered into a book, which shall be maintained for the due business of the trust.

All resolutions and proceedings of any meeting of the trustees and acts done in presence of its be as valid as if every such persons has or have been duly appointed and was fit enough to be a Trustee, even if it is discovered afterwards that there was some defect in

POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE TRUST:

- (i) An account savings or current shall be opened in the name of the trust to be signed and operated by any two of which one among the chairman, vice-chairman and managing trustee and one should be treasurer elected among the board of trustees.
- (ii) The Trustees are empowered to authorize any other Trustee to operate the bank account subject to certain limit in specific circumstances.
